Qualifies for certification in:

Special Education, K–12 mild to moderate disabilities and Elementary Education, K–8

This two-year program with PESD is offered to students in their junior and senior year at ASU. It prepares students to work with typical children as well as those with mild-to-moderate disabilities and includes a full Structured English Immersion endorsement to work with English language learners.

Arizona Teachers Academy at ASU scholarship

Offered by: Arizona State University

The ATA at ASU scholarship covers last dollar tuition and fees for eligible students who are Arizona residents and fulfill a commitment to teach in Arizona public schools after graduation. Learn more: education.asu.edu/ata



Paid teaching apprenticeships

Offered by: Pendergast Elementary School District

Students may apply for a paid apprenticeship position with PESD to take place their senior year. The number of paid positions are limited and vary each semester.



Pendergast transition stipend

Offered by: Pendergast Elementary Community Foundation
