



The Pendergast Family Resource Center (PFRC) follows the Pendergast (PESD) Mitigation Plan for Re-Opening Schools which can be viewed on the district website at <http://www.pesd92.org/>.

**When PESD school sites re-open, the following protocols will be implemented at the PFRC.**

### Pendergast Family Resource Center Re-Opening Guidelines

The PFRC staff will continue to offer virtual programming. Please see the monthly newsletter with activity calendar, or visit our webpage, <http://www.pesd92.org/familyresourcecenter.html>, to register for live adult-child Zoom classes and parenting workshops.

#### Online Class Registration

Online registration is required for all classes. This can be done through the PFRC webpage or the monthly activity calendar. In order to provide a safe experience for all families, open attendance at classes without advance registration is no longer available.

If you are unable to attend a class after registration has been confirmed, please immediately notify the PFRC staff at 623-772-2339, so the space may be offered to another family.

#### Enhanced Social Distancing - In-person Classes (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 6)

We will notify PFRC families when it is possible to begin in-person classes. Once classes can safely resume in person they will be smaller in size and social distancing guidelines will be followed. At least 6 feet of distance will be maintained between individuals at all times possible. Adults will be asked to actively monitor their children. In-person classes may take place on the PESD Community Center outdoor patio area and multi-purpose room when available to support social distancing measures.

**Class Size Restrictions – In-person Classes** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 4)

All adult-child interactive classes will be limited to 1 adult accompanied by no more than two children, aged birth to five. Classes will be limited to **five** families in order to support social distancing and safety protocols. The playroom will not be open for use after classes until further notice.

**Face Coverings** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 9)

All persons, including staff and visitors to the PFRC (including parents and children 5 years and older) shall wear a face covering while in the PESD Community Center or at any PFRC location. Although recommended, children under the age of five are not required to wear face coverings. As recommended by the CDC, face coverings should not be worn by children under the age of two. Adult and child-sized masks are available at the PFRC, if needed.

**Hand Washing** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 9)

All persons, including PFRC staff, families and young children, will wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol at the following times:

- Upon arrival at the PESD Community Center or PESD Family Resource center location
- Prior to leaving the center/class for home
- After sneezing, coughing or blowing nose and following toileting use

**PFRC Class Materials** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 10)

Materials needed to complete projects during adult-child interactive classes will be individually organized and distributed to each family. As per CDC guidelines, sharing materials is not recommended.

**Computer Access** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 6)

Community use of FRC computers is available during the afternoon on an appointment basis. Please call us at 623-772-2339 to schedule an appointment.

**Resource and Referral Appointments** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 6)

In order to provide PFRC families the best possible customer experience, the PFRC staff will meet individually with any adult requesting resources or community referrals. These appointments need to be scheduled in advance, by calling the center at 623-772-2339.

**Daily Health Screenings** (PESD COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Plan, p. 4)

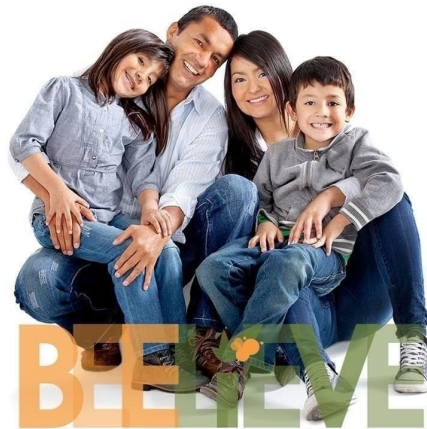
Families planning to visit the Pendergast Family Resource Center must be symptom free from the following health concerns.

- Fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, or chills
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle aches
- Sore throat, headache, fatigue, congestion or runny nose, cough, vomiting, diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell
- Any other symptoms identified in the future as being COVID-19 related

**After attending a PFRC class, please notify the PFRC at 623-772-2339, if a family member tests positive, any family member finds out they have been exposed, or if COVID-19 symptoms are experienced.**

The PESD Family Resource Center staff appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we move forward with re-opening. We value sharing time with families, and want everyone's experience to be safe and comfortable.
